



### **Entry Level Water and Wastewater Operator**

Elbert Creek Water Company (ECWC) has an opening for an Entry Level Water and Wastewater Operator. Operator will receive extensive training and support for career development/advancement to become professionals in Water and Wastewater operations as well as Distribution and Collection systems operations and maintenance.

#### **Elbert Creek Water Company**

ECWC provides water and wastewater services to the Glacier golf club and Tamarron Resort as well as neighboring communities. The entry level operator will assist the ECWC team with a variety of duties related to the day-to-day operations of Glacier's water treatment facility and wastewater treatment system ensuring delivery of safe, potable water to ECWC customers as well as Glacier members, staff, contractors, and guests and the environmentally safe return of wastewater to the ECWC wastewater treatment plant.

#### **Job Duties**

The entry level operator will assist the ECWC team with a variety of duties related to the day-to-day operations. Typical duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Routine inspections of the water distribution system and wastewater collections system equipment.
- Routine inspections of the water and wastewater treatment plants.
- Operations of treatment plants including chemical addition and handling.
- Inspecting and completing maintenance on equipment on a regular basis.
- Monitor operating conditions, meters, and gauges.
- Collecting and testing water and wastewater samples.
- Record meter and gauge readings, and operational data.
- Operate specialized equipment for domestic water treatment.
- Operate specialized equipment for wastewater treatment and sludge disposal.
- Clean and maintain equipment, tanks, filter beds, and other work areas.
- Perform regular housekeeping ensuring a clean and safe working area.

#### **Requirements**

- Water industry experience is a preferred but is not required.
- Must be at least 18 years old with a high school diploma or GED.

- Must have a valid Colorado Driver's License, acceptable history, and must maintain throughout employment.
- Position requires pre-employment background check.
- Must live within an acceptable distance of the Glacier Club for emergency and on-call response time.
- Must be able to work any hours necessary and be available for on-call schedules.
- Must be physically capable of performing all duties required of a water/wastewater operator, including working in inclement weather and lifting heavy objects.
- Must be detailed oriented and comfortable will collecting, entering, and analyzing data.
- Must have some laboratory, computer, and mechanical skills.
- Must obtain minimum operating licenses within 1 year of start date.
- Must work well in a small team setting.
- Position also requires a professional appearance and attitude and providing excellent customer service.

### **Compensation**

Starting pay is \$18.00-\$19.00 per hour depending on experience with an additional increase to \$22.00 upon the receipt of the first four base operating licenses, including: Water Treatment D, Distribution 1, Wastewater Treatment D, and Collections 1.
